

Preservation Plan and Historic Building Inventory Update Tacoma, Washington



Over the past decade, the City of Tacoma has taken substantial steps to protect and preserve its cultural heritage. The City now seeks to refine its historic preservation program by crafting a plan to coordinate preservation efforts within a broader framework of community and economic development objectives.

Winter & Company is crafting an updated historic preservation plan that will become part of the City of Tacoma Comprehensive Plan. This will be followed by development of a revised strategy for conducting historic surveys and an update to the historic building inventory. In the final phase of the project, Winter & Company will assist with implementation of the preservation plan, which could include revisions to the preservation ordinance or other city codes as well as development of new incentive programs for historic preservation.



Integrating preservation policies with overall community goals is a key objective for the project. The preservation plan will help the City balance redevelopment objectives with preservation policies and will promote community sustainability goals. The final preservation plan will be complete by late 2010.
