Design Guidelines for Historic Sites and Districts

Montgomery County is filled with significant historic resources from its agrarian, industrial and commercial past. Taken as a whole, these landmarks, neighborhoods and communities help define the county. Recognizing the importance of these historic artifacts, the County has established a comprehensive program to identify and protect this three-century old legacy.



As part of the preservation efforts, Winter & Company helped the County develop a master set of general rehabilitation design guidelines which address treatment of historic properties including repair, rehabilitation and the design of alterations and additions to historic properties. The guidelines document serves both as an informational document for property owners who are planning improvements and as a decision-making tool for the Historic Preservation Commission.
