

Boston Training Workshops

In many larger communities a variety of boards and commissions, as well as city staff, may conduct design review for historic and conservation districts. In some cases, this diversity of review bodies can lead to an appearance of inconsistent review procedures and policies in the community. Concerned that such an appearance would undermine review processes, the City of Boston staged a series of training workshops for the Boston Landmarks Commission and related neighborhood design review boards as well as city staff. The training sessions included team discussions about how the various review bodies related to each other, how some basic design principles could be developed that would provide an umbrella for more specific neighborhood-based guidelines, and mock review sessions.
